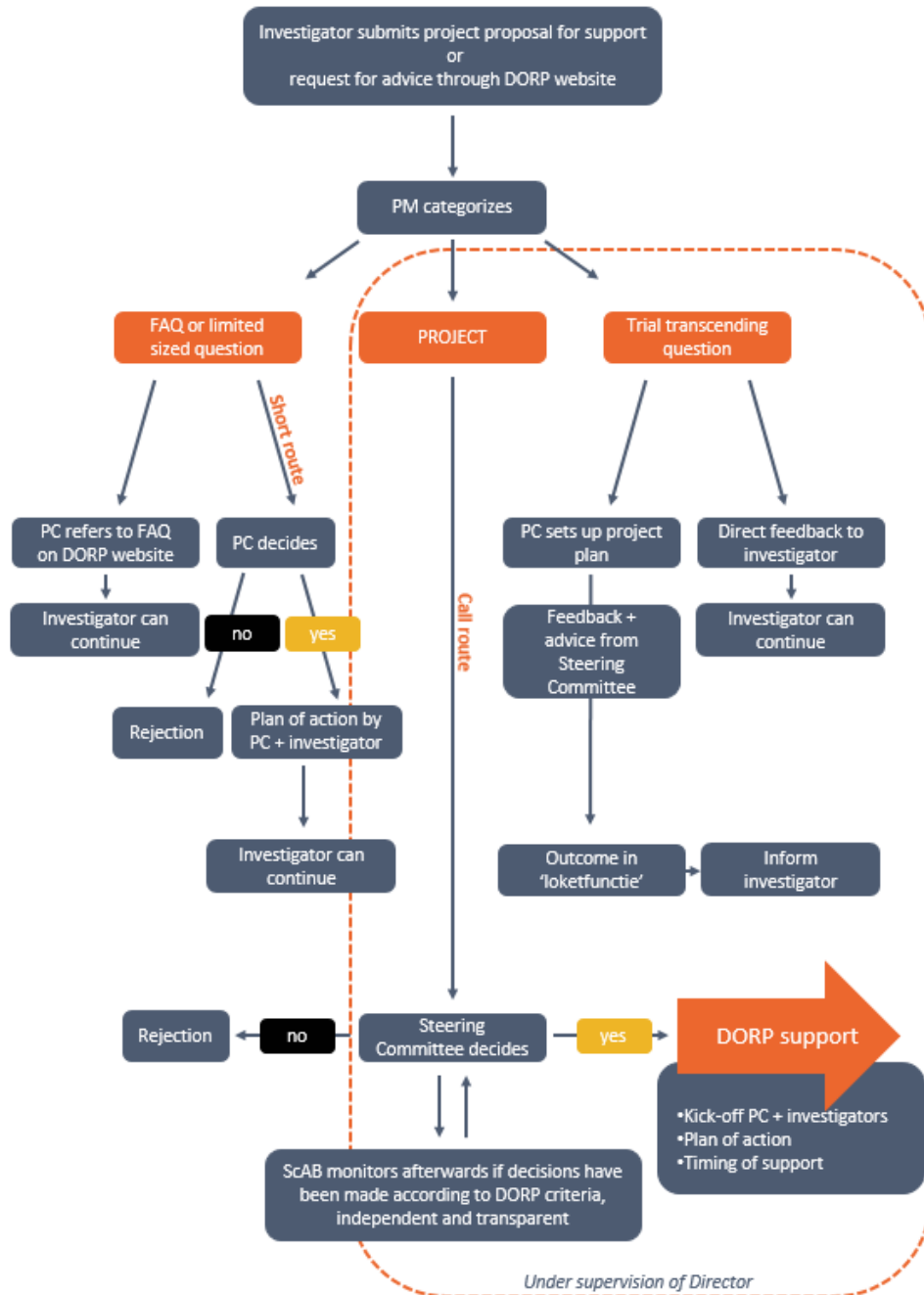


DORP Call process policy

The routing of three different types of requests for support by DORP

Three categories of requests for support by DORP are identified:

1) FAQ and limited sized questions

The PM receives the request and checks if the question can be categorized as FAQ or limited sized. If categorized as FAQ, the PM refers the investigator to the 'loketfunctie' on the DORP website. If categorized as limited sized question, a 'short route' may apply for questions and advice that can be processed right away. The PM forwards the request to the relevant PC, who has been given a mandate by the DORP director to process these requests at his/her own discretion. The PM/PC/director register all requests to be able to make an inventory of the needs, which can contribute to the 'loketfunctie'.

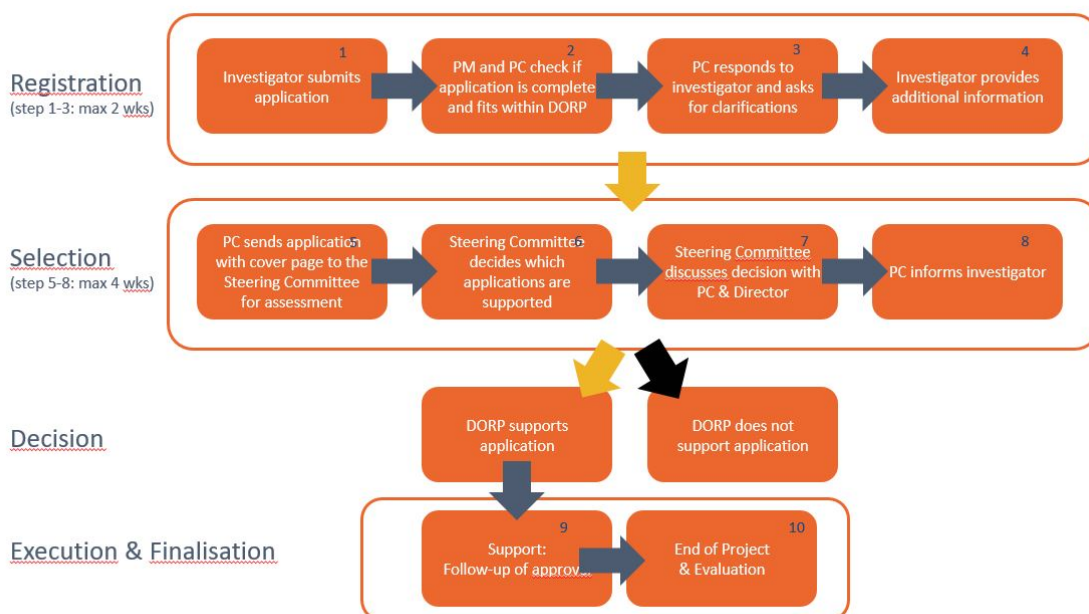
2) Project

Project requests enter the 'call route' in which finally the Board will decide if the project will be supported by DORP. The call route is outlined in the process flow above.

3) Trial transcending questions

Trial transcending questions are generally not project specific and potentially not quickly solved. The investigator will get feedback but DORP may not be able to provide support (directly). If the question is relevant to the clinical oncology research community, the PC will escalate towards the Director and set up a plan how to address the question or problem on request and under the supervision of the Director. The DORP board and ScAB are available to give feedback and advice.

Outline Call route for "Project"



The call will be open continuously to allow investigators to submit their project anytime. Therewith support can be started timely. This gives the PM, PC, Director and Board flexibility in evaluating projects thereby spreading the work and effort for assessment, advice and decision making over time. Investigators are informed about the opportunity to submit their request for support by DORP through the DORP website (through application form). The call will be announced on the DORP website and through the newsletters.
